Under the patronage of the Kuwait National Council for Culture, Arts & Letters, “Armenian Art in Kuwait”, in collaboration with Aramé Art Gallery, presents “Magical Transformations” – a unique exhibition featuring a new collection of more than 50 beautiful artworks.

These original paintings were created by the most talented and renowned Armenian artists of the present, united by Aramé Art Gallery – the leading art gallery of Armenia. Founded in 2003, Aramé has two branches in the capital of Armenia – Yerevan. The gallery is also well known internationally, with branches in Lebanon and Kuwait.

In spite of having very different styles and techniques, Aramé’s artists have one thing in common – they all have been inspired and are the carriers of the unique Armenian culture, and each of them adds new colours and his own special contribution to that rich heritage.

Be it the open air, impressionist compositions by Areg Elibekian, the allegoric, otherworldly visions of Ruben Grigorian, or the surrealist revelations by Vahagn Haroutyunian, the observers will always have the sensation that they all emanate from the same source.

Almost unknowingly, and very spontaneously, all these artists are playing a part in the creation of a marvelous opus – a symphony that has transformed for centuries, has developed through many stages, welcoming and including new notes and undertones, and leaving behind others, but always remaining true to its essence – the magical transformations of Armenian Art.

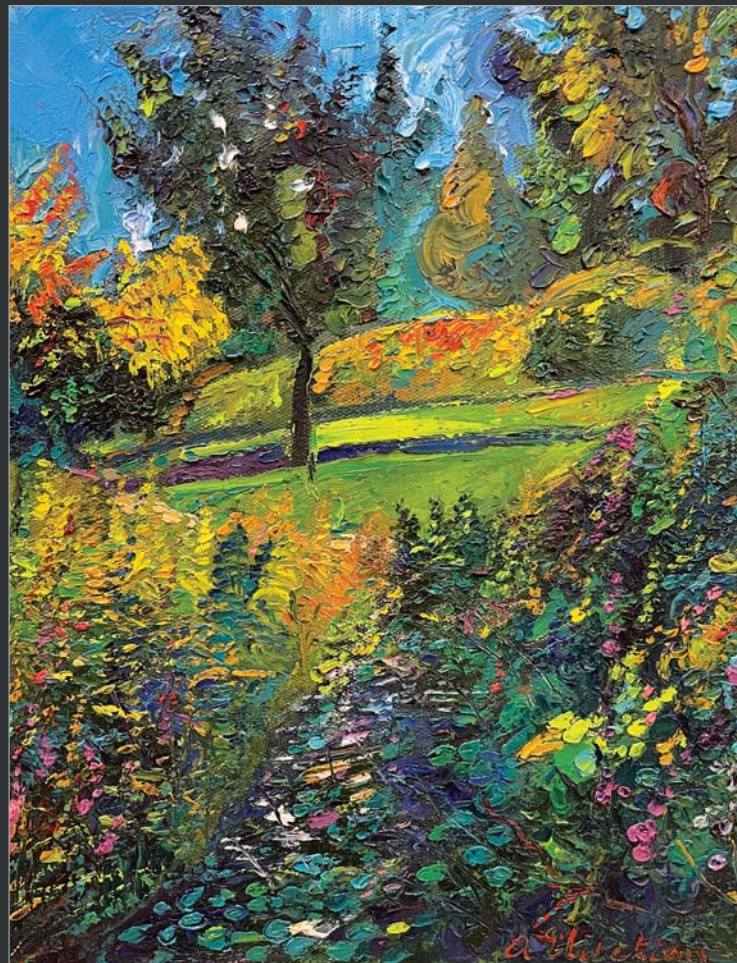
Areg Elibekian

1970 Born in Yerevan, Armenia Since 1992 he lives and works in Montreal, Canada.

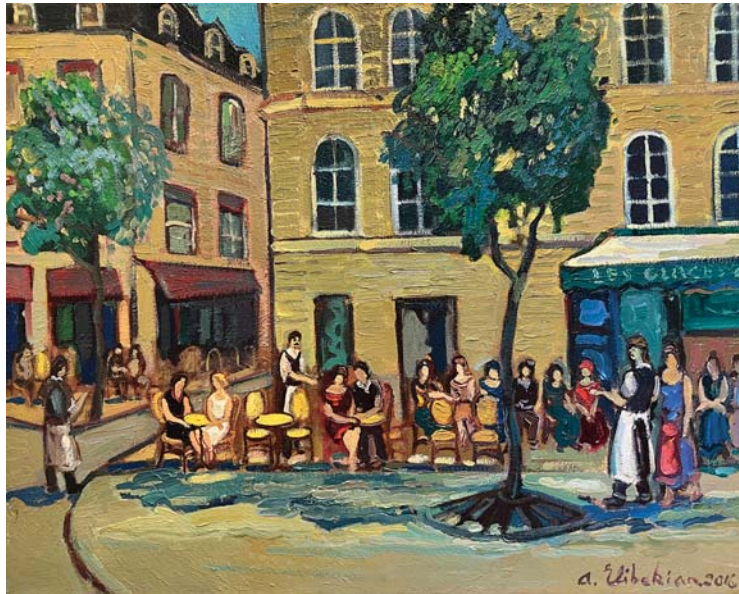
Areg's works are displayed at the Modern Art Museum of Yerevan and Alex & Marie Manoogian Museum of Detroit, USA.

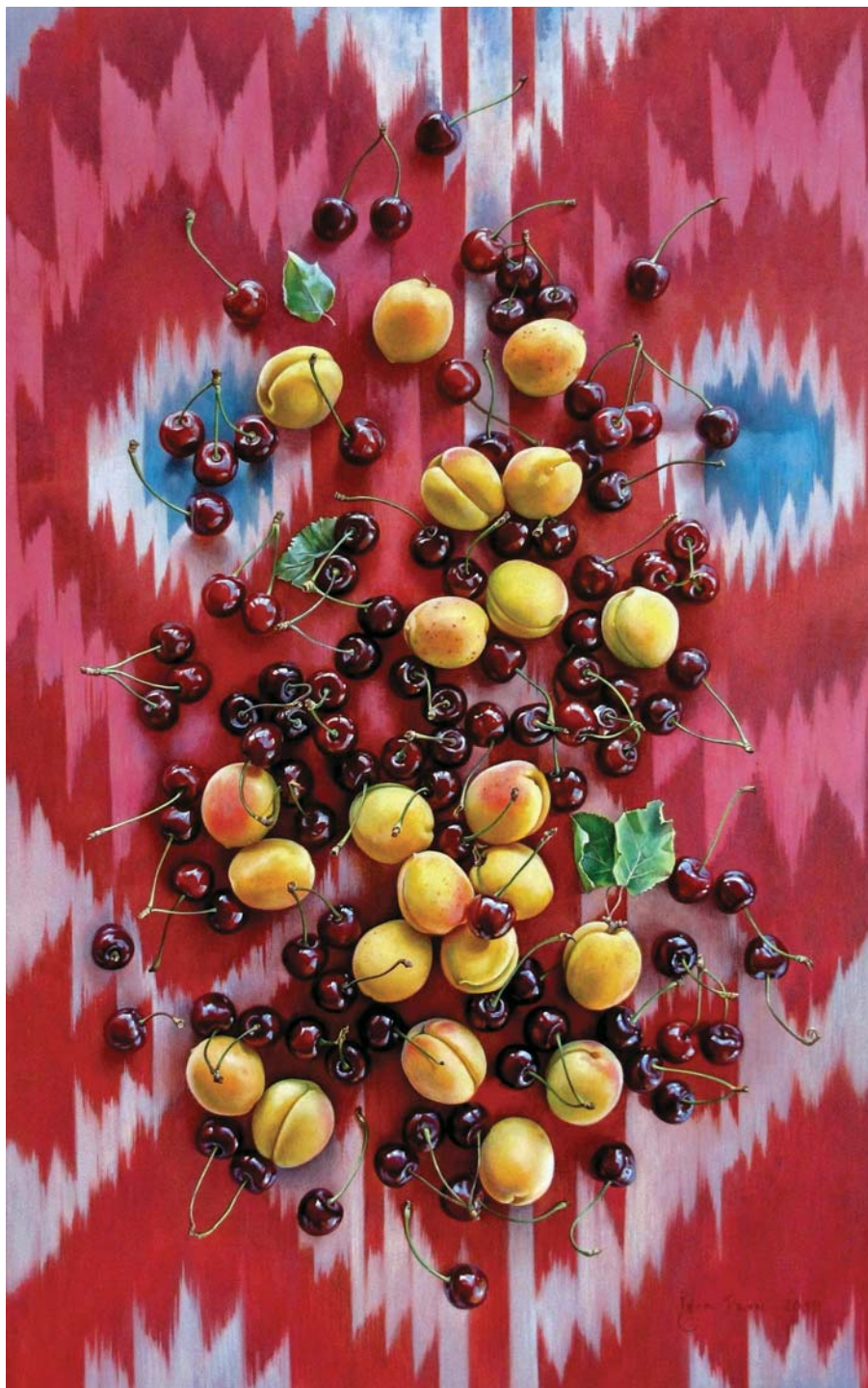

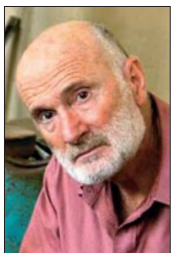

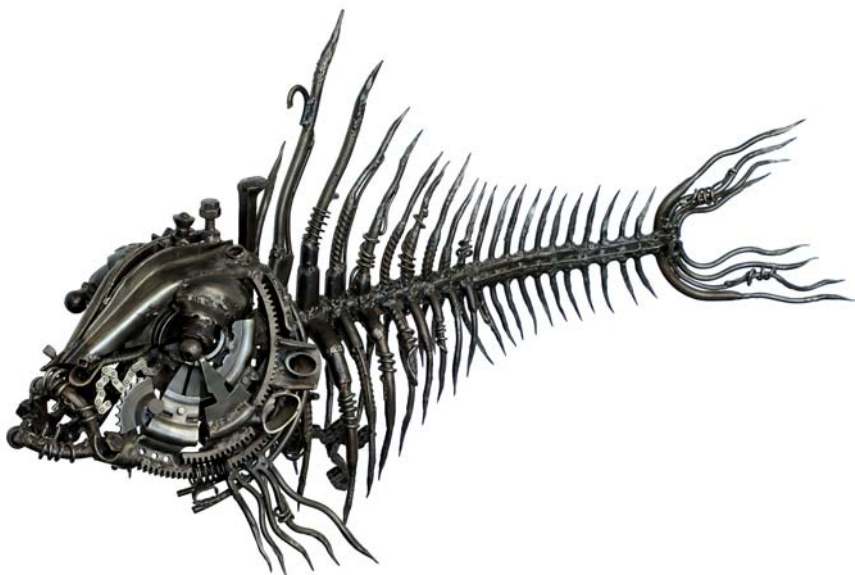
